



<p>What is Powder Horn?</p>	<p><b>Powder Horn</b> is a high adventure resource management course of the Boy Scouts of America. Powder Horn helps Scout leaders learn how to safely conduct fun and challenging outdoor activities, provides an introduction to the resources needed for a successful high adventure program, and a basic understanding of what is involved in different high adventure disciplines. <i><b>The course is designed for you to experience different high adventure activities, and is not an event to learn specific skills or earn skill certifications.</b></i></p>
<p>Who can attend?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Any registered adult, including Cub Scout, Boy Scout, Varsity Scout, Sea Scout and Venturing Leaders!</b></li> <li>• <b>Any 16 year old or older Venturer or Boy Scout</b></li> <li>• <b>Any 15 year old Boy Scout or Venturer holding a position of responsibility in their unit, or at the district, council, area, or regional level</b></li> </ul>
