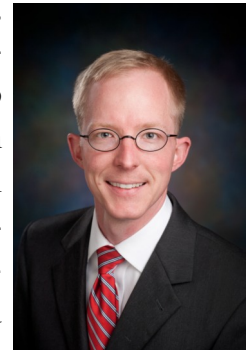




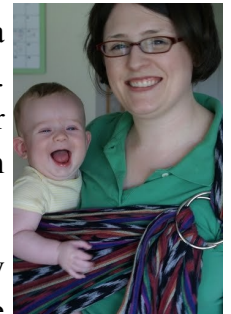
# Introducing The Nolle Family Luke, Sophie, Angie and Dave
