\* Be prepared for cold weather by including extra set(s) of long trousers and long-sleeved shirts and jacket. Also, if for personal reasons, long trousers must be worn, this is permissible.

**Note:** All will be in official BSA uniform (the first six items on the required list) before moving to the campsite. Backpack (or backpack type duffel) must be used for getting gear to the campsite and outpost camps. Candidates must not use suitcases, footlockers, or trunks at the campsite. Normal prescribed patrol equipment will be issued. Before coming, see that all badges and insignia are properly on uniform. Only the BSA official uniform and parts are acceptable. You are encouraged to borrow uniform and required items you do not already own (talk to your Scoutmaster for resource leads). The NYLT is physically demanding, it includes hikes and a canoe camp.
